YOUR TASKS

- Commodity trading is increasingly affected by sector-specific regulations (REMIT for gas and power) or by broader regulatory requirements that affect commodities (EMIR, MiFID, MiFIR, MAR). The Regulatory Strategy Officer analyses such regulatory requirements of European energy markets and global commodity markets and similar regulations outside Europe.
- The risk and chances arising from these regulatory requirements are driven by client preferences and possible market reactions. The Regulatory Strategy Officer identifies the clients' preferences

in close cooperation with other departments and via direct interactions with clients as well as industry organizations.

- The regulatory strategy is an increasingly important element of the strategies of Powernext and EEX Group. Based on the analysis of regulatory requirements and of client preferences, the Regulatory Strategy Officer derives strategic recommendations regarding the product portfolio and the regulatory setup of Powernext and EEX Group.
