In order to support the strong development of the PEGAS markets, Powernext is looking for an analyst to strengthen its Market Surveillance department. This team is in charge of the continuous monitoring of the PEGAS markets to ensure integrity and transparency. For this purpose, Market Surveillance has extensive access to all the trading data, perform quantitative analyses and constantly interacts with market members and other departments within Powernext or at the EEX group level (e.g. regulation, compliance, market operations, management).

The Market Surveillance Analyst will be involved in all the different responsibilities of the team, including regular monitoring and investigation, maintenance of the surveillance system, participation in members controlling and interaction with the different stakeholders.

- Participate in the continuous monitoring of the PEGAS markets, including first assessment of automatic alerts, ad-hoc quantitative analyses and regular follow-up of market developments (fundamentals, prices, regulation)

- Conduct in-depth analyses on unusual or suspicious trading behaviour, handle requests for information to market members and draft investigation reports
- Participate in the analysis of the registries operated by Powernext
- Contribute to the improvement and fine-tuning of the surveillance system (e.g. modelling and implementation of new alerts, calibration and back-test of alert thresholds, analysis and reporting tools)
- Participate in regular workshops and ad-hoc meetings with stakeholders of the surveillance activity, including regulators (AMF and European energy regulators) and market members
- Support KYC and scoring tasks of new market members and prospects
